RULES FOR CHILDREN ATTENDING WICKWAR OUT OF SCHOOL CLUB

Parents/carers are asked to make sure that their children understand the following requirements and restrictions, which are necessary for the smooth running of the club and the safety of the children and staff:

1. The Club expects:

- Respect and good manners towards staff and other children at all times.

Children should:

- Respond appropriately and politely when asked to do something by a member of staff
- Respect other children and allow them to play, without annoyance or interruption
- Play co-operatively and abide by the club rules
- Use appropriate language

2. The Club will not accept:

Aggressive or abusive behaviour, physical or verbal, to either children or staff. This will not be tolerated and will be dealt with by staff who will adhere to the clubs Disciplinary Procedure.

Children should not: -

- Throw any items of play equipment or any other articles likely to cause injury
- Operate the TV or video or any electrical equipment
- Climb on any fence, wall or gate
- Enter the cupboards without permission from a member of staff
- Bring any item or substance likely to be damaging to their own or other children's health.
- Touch any administrative files or registers.

3. Children are expected to help clear up toys, equipment and litter when asked to do so by a member of staff.

4. Cases of theft from other children or from the club, or deliberate damage to club equipment or other children's belongings, will be referred to the manager/committee. Parents will be liable for the replacement of the said item or equipment.

As laid down in the Disciplinary Procedure, the staff can impose immediate exclusion of a child in the case of a sudden serious disciplinary problem. Children who have been suspended should be removed from the club or play scheme as soon as possible by the child's parent or carer
